Sunday 1st

Thank God that the HEAL Africa Hospital has cared for 949 patients since the January attack on Goma, including providing spiritual support from Chaplains. Please pray for the 34 people still being treated.

Monday 2nd

Ask God to give for wisdom and clarity to the teachers at JKPS' Bethel Training Institute in India as they select candidates for their online Community Transformation Programme which begins this month.

Tuesday 3rd

Praise God for the opening of Potter's House's first dental clinic in Chiquimula, Guatemala. Ask God for provision in raising funds for the necessary equipment.

Wednesday 4th

Thank God that an Easter event, organised by the Evangelical Church in North Macedonia for 50 children, has led to over 70 children regularly attending a Bible class.

Thursday 5th

Please pray for WorldShare as we begin the process of developing a ChildAid sponsorship platform. Pray for creativity and wisdom as we look for the best way to support our sponsors.

Friday 6th

Ask God to provide financially for PiFò Haiti so they can renovate the preschool section of Monal and Maccia's school, which is in desperate need of repair.

Saturday 7th

Pray for High Priest Academy in Ghana as they face challenges from increased enrolment, such as not enough classroom space and inadequate funds for school lunches.

Sunday 8th

Ask God to help Wakisa Ministries in Uganda to raise the funds for Phase 3 of their new Maternity Centre which includes installing electricity.

Monday 9th

Please pray for the Community Health Evangelism training reviews to be completed, so Medical Ambassadors Foundation can begin this ministry in Albania.

Tuesday 10th

Please pray for the WorldShare team as we start the preparation of our Charity Gifts catalogue. Pray that these gifts will have a great impact on those we support.

Wednesday 11th

Continue to hold in prayer the people of Gaza. Due to food shortage, it now costs Christian Mission to Gaza \$11 to give away one meal. May God provide all they need to continue their aid.

Thursday 12th

Please pray for WorldShare's Board of Trustees as they meet today for their board meeting. Pray for many wise and fruitful decisions to be made.

Friday 13th

Ask for God's wisdom and guidance for Kanal Hayat in Türkiye as they explore new fundraising paths. Pray that more testimonies will be shared, and that this will inspire more support.

Saturday 14th

Praise God for all those who participated in our 10k fundraising event at Rutland Water last month and who helped raise lots of money (match-funded!) to support the dormitory rebuild in Myanmar.

Sunday 15th

Thank God for Beginning of Life in Moldova's Urban Psychological Art Studio, where over 200 Ukrainian refugees find healing, hope and expression through creativity and art therapy.
